

Guðný Björk Eydal graduated as social worker from the University of Iceland and as MSW and PhD at the University of Gothenburg. Eydal is Professor and Head of Faculty at the Faculty of Social Work, University of Iceland. Her main research field is social, family and care policies in Iceland and the Nordic countries and currently she is directing a long-term research project on the outcome of the paid parental leave legislation in Iceland with Ingólfur V. Gíslason. She has also been directing a Nordic research project in the field of disaster social work, *The Nordic welfare watch in response to changes*, where the role of social services in all five Nordic countries in times of disasters has been investigated. Among her recent publications is the book *Handbook on family policy* that she edited with Professor Tine Rostgaard. In addition to teaching courses in family and social policy, Eydal has developed courses in disaster and environmental social work at the Faculty of Social Work at the University of Iceland.
